## BALLOON POP GAME INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print the Balloon Pop Questions.
2. Print the Balloon Pop Answers.
3. Cut the questions apart.
4. Place each of the questions in a separate balloon, inflate the balloon and tie it.
5. Divide the class into two teams.
6. Each team will take a turn selecting a balloon, popping it, and reading the question. If they can answer the question correctly, they are awarded a point. (If you choose, you may assign a different value to each question.)
7. If the team cannot answer the question correctly, the other team will have a chance to answer the question and be awarded the points.
8. Someone will keep score of the points awarded to each team.
9. After all the questions have been answered, the team with the most points wins!

- 9. Should Christians worry about what will happen to them at the end time?**
- 10. What will happen to the Christians at the end time if they stand firm?**
