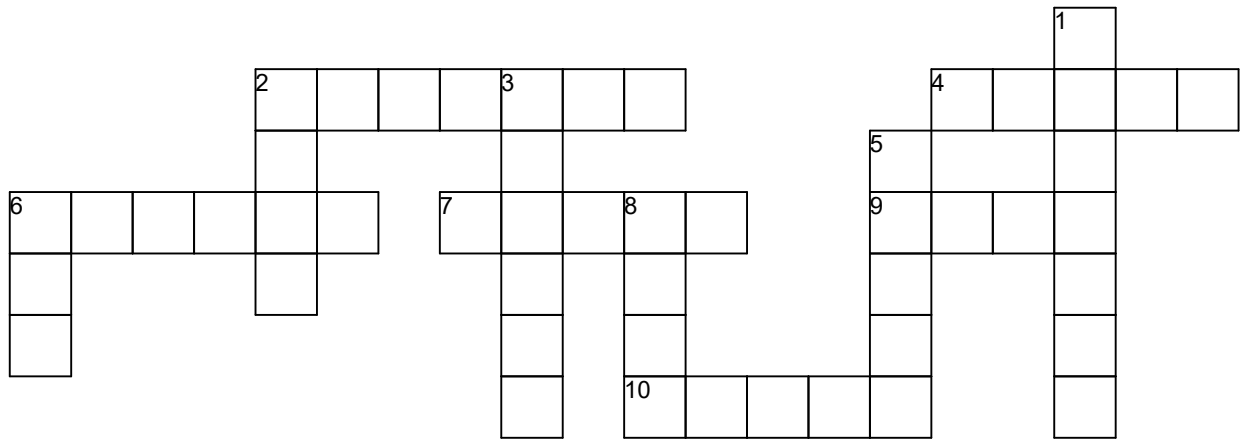




Elijah Is Fed by Ravens
