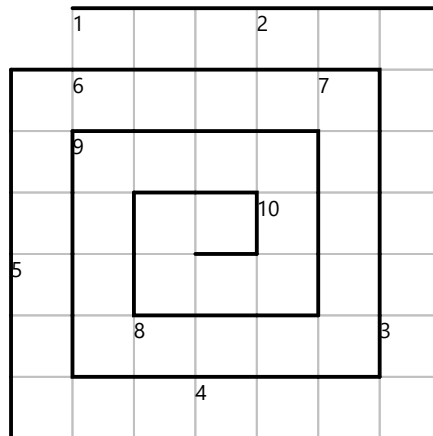


# Adam and Eve and the Sneaky Snake
