

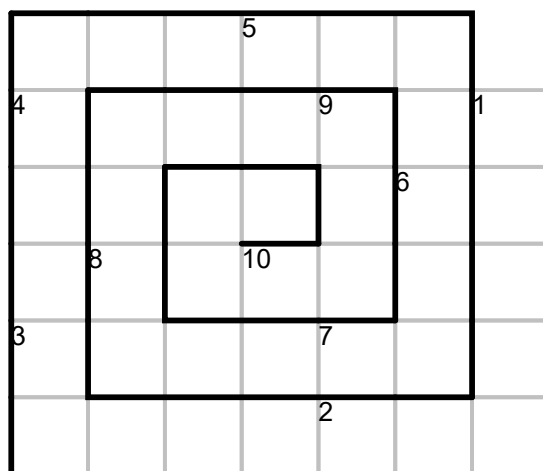


# What a Catch!
